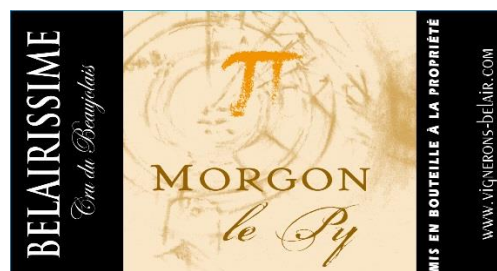


2016 Vignerons de Bel Air • Morgon le Py

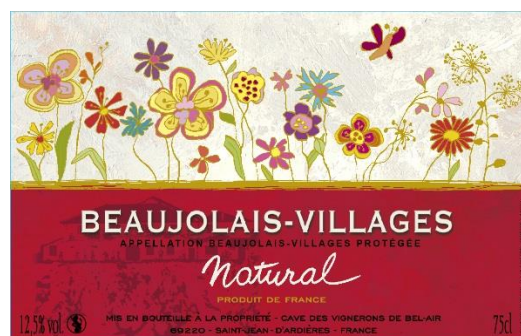

The 2016 Morgon le Py spends six months in wood (30% of the crop) while the rest is raised in stainless steel. It has a generous red cherry and raspberry-scented bouquet with light undergrowth notes coming through with time. The palate is well balanced with a bright and lively entry: tensile red cherries mixed with raspberry and strawberry, showing a degree of elegance toward the composed finish. This is very well crafted.
