



DOMAINE DE GUILHON DAZE – DENIS TASTET Cotes de Gascogne – Bas Armagnac – Walnut wine



A century old Domaine of 60 hectares, located between Bordeaux and Toulouse, at Larée, near Cazaubon. Sandy loam soils planted with Colombard, Sauvignon Blanc, Gros Manseng, Petit Manseng, Ugni Blanc for the white grapes. Red grapes are Baco noir, Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Syrah, Tannat.

2019 Cotes de Gascogne “Tonnelle”: Blend of Colombard, Sauvignon Blanc and Ugni Blanc. Crisp pale yellow color with hints of green rim, rich nose of citrus and tropical fruit, passion fruit, medium body on the palate with the same flavors knit into a crisp fresh and ripe acidity, followed by a persistent finish. Lovely.

Walnut wine: A true delicacy!

VIN DE NOIX: 17% Alcohol. Fortified red wine, made with Bas-Armagnac in which walnut leaves and bogs have macerated with sugar. All products are 100% natural and 100% estate grown and produced. Ideal companion for your cheese tray, all kinds of nuts, and red fruit tarts, figs, crème brûlée, and so much more...

1989 Bas Armagnac: Made with 100% Baco Noir grapes. This spirit is full of flavors (chocolate, figs, licorice, black truffle, dried fruit), rich, bold, complex and powerful. Full body on the palate it coats your mouth with thick velvet and warmth. Powerful!
